

## Fall 2018 Bylaws Review

### Article VI Section 5

The Worshipful Master shall, immediately after his installation, appoint a building committee consisting of three members of the Lodge, and it shall be their duty to observe the physical condition of the building and make recommendations to the Worshipful Master for proper maintenance and repairs. It shall also be their duty to act as a liaison between the various tenants or organizations using the building and the Lodge: (1) to **work with the finance committee to review establish** fees for use of the dining room; ~~(2) to make an annual inventory of personal property of the Lodge and submit a written report on or before the first Stated Communication in April of each year.~~ (2) To take pictures of all rooms in the lodge to be stored offsite.

### Article VI Section 6 and 7 **STRIKE FROM BYLAWS**

The Worshipful Master shall appoint a Public-School Committee composed of not less than three and no more than six members whose duty it shall be to assist the Lodge in carrying out the programs of the Grand Lodge in support of the Public Schools and such further programs as the Lodge may deem advisable.

The Worshipful Master shall appoint a Committee on the Masonic Foundation consisting of three members, whose duty it shall be to coordinate the work of the Masonic Foundation and such contribution for and disseminate information concerning the operation of the Masonic Foundation.

### Article VII, Section 2

The annual membership dues of the Lodge shall be **Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)** ~~Thirty-Eight Dollars (\$38.00)~~ plus any Grand Lodge Per Capita Tax, per year beginning January 1st 2005. The dues of new members, (Grand Lodge by-laws 4-310) or a member affiliating, or one raised, is liable for the PRO-RATA proportion of the annual dues for the current year, but in no event less than the Per Capita tax and any assessment of the Grand Lodge. ~~except where non-payment of dues constituted cause of suspension, in which case all prior dues must be paid before restoration.~~ **In the case reinstatement after suspension for non-payment of dues, the brother must pay the current and previous years' dues.**

### Article VII, Section 3 -

Lodge dues shall be payable in advance and shall be delinquent if not paid on or before January 1 of each year. **Any member who is two years delinquent** ~~if some are not paid~~ by the date of the Annual Communication ~~in December, the member~~ shall be suspended as of that date (Grand Lodge by-laws 4-308).
